categories

aia design awards

- Built Work: New Construction, Preservation, Additions, Interior Design, Urban Design
- Small Projects: Residential and Commercial Projects under 10,000 square feet in area
- Architectural Advancement: Sustainable Projects or Research, Unbuilt or Visionary Projects, Architectural Illustrations

iida + asid design awards

- Built Work: New Construction and Renovations of Interior Projects
- Small Projects: Residential and Commercial Projects under 5,000 square feet in area

segd design awards

- Built Work: Environments, Wayfinding Signage, Exhibits, Temporary Projects
- Single Sign: An Individual Sign — stand alone or part of a system

asla design awards

- Built Work: Residential, Parks, Urban Design, Streetscapes, Hospitality, Landscape Art, Interior Landscapes, Gardens
- Unbuilt Work: Studies, Concepts, Planning, Research, Analysis, Reclamation

open design awards

Category open to all members and non-members; limited to individual artists, artisans, or design professionals

- Distinguished Detail/Product: An Element, Ornament, Custom Product, Application, Fixture or Furnishing.

cincinnati magazine design awards

Category open to all

- Residential: Singular Space — Living Room, Dining Room, Bedroom, Kitchen, Bath
- Outdoor Living Space
- Rising Star: Residential or Small Commercial space by a design professional under the age of 40 or a design firm operating for 5 years or less.

Number of awards in any category is subject to the discretion of the jury

eligibility

The submitting firm must have a local office actively involved in the project and be a current member of the organization to which they are submitting an entry. Non-members may submit at a non-member rate.

The submitting firm must be the Designer of Record, responsible for the overall design of the project concept. Submissions by design teams and joint ventures shall be eligible for the member fee only when the Designer of Record is a local member.

Projects must have been completed after 01.01.2006.

The completed Call for Entry must be received at the AIA Cincinnati Chapter Office on or before 10.7.2011; All entry fees must be paid in full at that time.

submissions

Entries will be submitted digitally and are due on or before 10.28.2011.

Additionally, a digital printout of select images will be required. Detailed requirements and project information forms will be mailed to each entrant upon receipt of registration form and entry fee. Entry fees are non-refundable.
